


Tawasentha Park Trail Map

Park Rules

- All pets must be leashed
- Beware of ticks
- No Motorized Vehicles
- No Horses
- No Hunting
- Leave flowers and plants for others to enjoy
- Stay on trails (except in Main Park Area)

- All trails are of a moderate difficulty level unless otherwise noted.
- Be careful of footing in wet/icy conditions

Tawasentha Park, a 192.5 acre jewel in the geographic center of the Town of Guiderland, was created with the acquisition of two large tracts of land.

The first tract of 95 acres, the main park section, was purchased in 1969 and is located east of the Normans Kill and south of Route 146. Prior to the Town's purchase, the property had already been enjoyed by many Guiderland residents for swimming, picnicking and other outdoor activities.

The second tract of 97.5 acres, the Winter Recreation/Community Gardens section, was purchased in 1989 and is located west of the Normans Kill and on the north and south sides of Route 146. It had been operated as a dairy farm for many years.
