Dear Mr. Kovalchik;

As a resident of Guilderland, I ask you to uphold your duties to serve this community by refusing to approve any development by the Pyramid LLC without a public hearing. The members of this community deserve to be heard and cannot be shut out of the decision-making process. Guilderland is a town of people, of families, of neighbors, of friends: not of corporations. Our town is the one being threatened by Pyramid's plans to develop an additional 47 acres of the rare and fragile Pine Bush habitat, it is unjust for these outsiders to make unilateral decisions that will put our neighborhoods and our futures at risk for the sake of their bank accounts.

Out of respect for your constituents and your community, I ask that you please put this project on hold until such time that the COVID-19 related shelter-in-place is lifted and a proper community forum can be safely held on the matter. We must not let big corporations take advantage of this grave situation to skirt around the law and fast track their own selfish interests at our expense as they have already shamefully done with the wooded lot across from the Capital City Diner and Market 32.
