Getting a Dog Park Permit:

For the safety of dog park users and their dogs, an annual permit is needed for those wishing to use the dog park. To obtain your permit, please complete this form and send it with payment to Town of Guilderland, Town Clerk, P.O. Box 339, Guilderland, NY 12084-0339. If you are an active military member or veteran, please include a copy of your military ID card or a copy of your driver's license (if it includes your military information to receive the discount). Permits are valid from the date of issue until December 31st.

Rules of the Dog Park

1. Usage is restricted to Town of Guilderland residents with current dog licenses. Dog licenses are available at the Town Clerk's office at Town Hall.
2. Dog park permits are only issued to adults 18 years of age or older. The permit holder must be the person to accompany the dog to the park.
3. Dogs must display a current rabies tag and park tag while inside the dog park.
4. All dog park permits expire at the end of the calendar year.
5. A dog must be at least 6 months of age to obtain a permit and visit the dog park.
6. All dogs present must be registered with the town and have a current rabies tag number and expiration date on file. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to notify the town of an updated rabies tag number and expiration date.
7. When visiting the dog park, the permit holder must stay with their dog at all times.
8. Habitual barking that unreasonably disturbs any person (other than the dog owner) is prohibited.
9. Rawhide, dog treats, and food are prohibited.
10. Owners must stop their dog from digging and holes must be filled.
11. Dog-training classes are prohibited.
12. No more than 2 dogs per owner are allowed at one time.
13. Alcohol is not allowed in the dog park.
14. Permit holders must clean up after their dogs in the dog park (including tall grass areas). This includes any waste as well as water bowls and dog toys.
15. Unhealthy dogs and those in heat are not allowed in the dog park.
16. Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the dog park.
17. Owners must remove their dog immediately from the dog park at the first sign of aggressive behavior. Dogs are not allowed to disturb, harass, or interfere with wildlife or other visitors. Permits may be revoked after repeated incidences of aggressive behavior or disturbance.
18. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult and not left unattended at the dog park.
19. In an emergency, dial 911.

I, _____, have read and agree to comply with the rules and regulations of the Guilderland Dog Park. Violators of these rules are subject to removal from the park and revocation of usage permits.
