



Vosburgh Trails traverse Town-owned open space in the Twenty West (70 acres) and French's Hollow Road (54 acres) subdivisions.

The **Red Trail** is a 1.05 mile easy to moderate loop trail over grasslands with views of the open space, stream bed, and Tawasentha Park.

The **Yellow Trail** is a 0.31 mile connector trail that links the Red and Blue Trails.

The **Blue Trail** is a 0.94 mile moderate to difficult loop trail along a crest overlooking the Normans Kill and leads to the Watervliet Reservoir and popular pedestrian bridge over the Normans Kill.

A round-trip hike from the Vosburgh Road trailhead to French's Mill Road is roughly 3 miles.

The trails are open year round for hiking and snowshoeing.

The trail entrances are marked at locations on Vosburgh Road, French's Mill Road and at the end of the sidewalk on Millingstone Way.

These trails and open spaces are environmentally sensitive and easily damaged. For these reasons, ATVs, motor bikes, and unauthorized motorized vehicles **are prohibited**.

## OTHER GREAT GUILDERLAND HIKES

- 1. Tawasentha Park Trails:** Tawasentha Park has roughly 5 miles of easy to moderate trails. The trails are also popular for snowshoeing and cross-country skiing.
- 2. Pine Bush Preserve Trails:** The Preserve has 18 miles of ten marked multiple use trails. The trails are considered easy to moderate, usually flat with gentle slopes, over sandy trails and woodland passages.
- 3. Bozen Kill Preserve Trails:** Bozen Kill Preserve is about 214 acres, with three trails, including the moderate Red Trail (0.64 miles), White Trail (0.58 miles) and the easy Mike Love Trail (0.17 miles).
- 4. Black Creek Marsh Management Area Trails:** This WMA consists of about 450 acres of wetland and upland habitat in Albany County. The area has approximately 3 miles of multiple use trails.



