

RESOLUTION NO. 2 of 2026

**AUTHORIZING THE USE OF TRANSFER STATION
RESERVE FUNDS FOR WEIGHT SCALE REPLACEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Guilderland Transfer Station Department has determined that the existing 40-year-old weight scale at the Transfer Station should be replaced (“Project”) because it does not pass 2-year inspections by Albany County’s Bureau of Weights and Measures;

WHEREAS, the Project will include a new scale, scale deck, electrical, concrete work, and ramps for entering and exiting the scale;

WHEREAS, the Town Board authorized the Transfer Station Department to issue a Request for Proposals for the Project;

WHEREAS, the Transfer Station Department has determined that there are not sufficient funds in the 2026 Town Budget to fund the Project;

WHEREAS, the Transfer Station Department has funds in the Transfer Station Reserve (R11) to provide part of the funding for the Project;

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Transfer Station Department and the Town Board have determined that the transfer of funds from the Transfer Station Reserve (R11) is an appropriate expenditure of reserve funds for the Project; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT

The Town Board authorizes the expenditure of funds from the Transfer Station Reserve (R11) for the Project;

Pursuant to NYS Town Law § 90 and NYS General Municipal Law § 6-c(4), this resolution is subject to a permissive referendum.
